Their presentation included many details of services of White Bird Clinic, Eugene's homegrown nonprofit which provides medical and dental care, drug and alcohol treatment, and crisis intervention to neighbors in need. That facility has been in continuous operation since 1970. Their innovative "Front Room" program helps folks by introducing them to services previously inaccessible.

Participants in attendance that day were pleased to learn many particulars about White Bird's mobile crisis intervention and medic unit "CAHOOTS" (Crisis Assistance Helping Out On The Streets) that day. Arlo coordinates that program. She amazed us with the scope of the situations CAHOOTS takes on.
